Major print shop in USA installs 750th pile-turner from POLAR

For the preparation of material before and after printing, 4Over.com from Los Angeles has recently invested into the 750th POLAR PW-4 ABV pile turner worldwide.

4Over.com was founded in 2001. The owner, Zarik Megerdichian started his business with a small team of people and used equipment. In 2003 he bought his first POLAR. Since then he invested in 9 of these high-speed cutters, and in 2008 he purchased another six!

Megerdichian developed from a little "garage-shop" into an internationally-acting commercial print shop with 266 employees and a second plant in Ohio: "We are doing very well in business so far and never had problems to find new customers. There are two simple reasons for our success: Quality and reliability! We take these two virtues very seriously when we produce goods for our customers.

That's why I always count on POLAR. We've never had any real problems with our POLAR high-speed cutters even though all our machines are running around the clock. That is one of the main reasons why the decision for this Pile Turner was made so fast. Previously my people had to put a lot of labor into turning the piles. Thus they enthusiastically welcomed the first PW-4. Today we very often use the turning and airing functions of the pile turner for drying the sheets before backing up jobs. With a workload of approx. With 30 skids of paper each day the pile turner saves us a lot of time and manpower."

Since its introduction at drupa 2000 POLAR pile turners have enjoyed an increase in popularity. After presenting a new generation with considerably optimized features at drupa 2004 the latest generation is offered since Dec 2006. With the jubilee machine, POLAR is positioning itself also as the market leader in pile turners.
